Colmar, an exceptional architectural heritage

The vast pedestrian zone of old Colmar, classified as a "safeguarded sector", displays a rich heritage, both civil and religious, perfectly preserved, from the Middle Ages to the 18th century, making it a real open-air museum.

- 1 • The "Little Venice" district** with its fascinating colourful facades.
- 2 • The Tanneurs district** and its large houses with white facades.
- 3 • The majestic Saint Martin Collegiate Church**, whose yellow Rouffach sandstone reflects the sun's rays in a shimmering fashion.

- 4 • The Pfister House**, Renaissance period, with a beautiful corner oriel and rich wall paintings.
- 5 • The majestic House of Heads** with its 106 face sculptures.
- 6 • The Koïfhus**, an emblematic place in the history of wine, whose roof offers a bewitching visual spectacle.

The Trois-Épis and its Galtz

The real Alsatian Corcovado

At Trois-Épis, in 1491, the Virgin Mary appeared to a blacksmith on his way to Niedermorschwihr. For more than 500 years, diocesan priests and religious communities have perpetuated the most famous Marian cult in Alsace. The Galtz is a rocky spur near the Trois-Épis on which a monumental statue of Christ blessing the Alsace plain was erected in 1930 in recognition of the return of Alsace to France. The hike is accessible and the view incredible!
